



**RATE YOUR
SELECTIONS**

In this document, I've listed the general criteria you can use to rate each of your shortlisted horses, using the various resources available within the Geegeez racecards.

Instant Expert

If betting to win, select "win" in the filters bar, and if betting to place, select "place" in the options bar. Then rate your selections as follows:

1pt awarded for each factor highlighted in GREEN.

0.5pt awarded for each factor highlighted in AMBER.

Suggestion: bet to win at odds of 9/2 or under, bet each way at odds of 5/1 or over.

Full Form

Select "new: proximity form" in the filters area, then rate your selections as follows:

2pts awarded if the most recent race is within 60 days, and highlighted in GREEN.

1pt awarded if the most recent race is within 60 days, and highlighted in AMBER.

If the most recent race is over 60 days ago, rate your selections as follows:

1pt awarded if the most recent race is highlighted in GREEN.

0.5pt awarded if the most recent race is highlighted in AMBER.

Pace

The pace tab is split into four sections; led, prominent, mid-division, and held up. Rate your selections as follows:

1pt awarded if the section your selections runs in, is highlighted in GREEN.

0.5pts awarded if the section your selections runs in, is highlighted in AMBER.

Suggestion: If necessary, adjust the filters to increase the sample size. Ideally, the "runs" column will have a sample size of at least 25 for each section.

Draw

The draw tab can only be used in races that use stalls i.e. on the flat and all weather. Rate your selections as follows:

1pt awarded if the draw for your selection is ranked in the top 3, according to win %.

0.5pts awarded if the draw for your selection is above average, according to win %.

Suggestion: If necessary, adjust the filters to increase the sample size. Ideally, the “runs” column will have a sample size of at least 25 for each draw.

Alternate Method: Pace & Draw Heat Map

Instead of analysing the pace and draw individually, you can use the “heat map” in the draw tab to rate your selections as follows:

2pts awarded if the section your selections runs in, is highlighted in dark or light GREEN.

1pt awarded if the section your selections runs in, is highlighted in YELLOW.

Suggestion: Use this method to reduce the time it takes to rate your selections.

Card Tab: Report Angles

1pt awarded for each report angle your selection qualifies under.

Suggestion: If possible, cross check each angle with the available data on the card, to ensure the statistic is meaningful (for example, individual “head to head” results).

Card Tab: Trainer & Jockey Form

1pt awarded if the trainer stats generally show a win rate of 20% or above, or an A/E above 1.

1pt awarded if the jockey stats generally show a win rate of 20% or above, or an A/E above 1.

Suggestion: Focus on long term form (course 1 & 5 year form), where the sample size is generally higher.

Class Move

1pt awarded if your selection is dropping 2 race classes or more

0.5pts awarded if your selection is dropping 1 race class

Comments & Summary

Awarding points for a favourable comment, or if your selection has been highlighted in the summary, is an optional extra and comes down to personal preference. If choosing to do so, you can rate your selections as follows:

1pt awarded if your selection is highlighted in the summary with a “(nap)” next to its name.

0.5pts awarded if your selection is highlighted in the summary.

Suggestion: Look at the comments & summary after rating your selections, and use them to round your ratings to the nearest whole number.
